

The Sooner Select Children's Specialty Program serves foster and former foster children, juvenile justice-involved children, and children receiving adoption assistance.

Starting April 1, 2024, eligible Sooner Care members will move to this plan. Oklahoma Complete Health is the provider for the Children's Specialty Program. Not only will they provide health care services, but they will also provide many value-added benefits for members. These include things like:

- Monetary incentives for behaviors such as engaging in healthy activities.
- Nutrition support including meals or annual funds to address food insecurity.
- Behavioral health coaching through a digital app
- Educational support that includes GED tutoring and testing vouchers
- Healthy weight incentives including memberships to the YMCA.
- Enhanced vision services such as funds for contacts or eyeglasses
- Legal assistance including record expungement.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority will be hosting a series of town halls for you to learn more about the Children's Specialty Program. These events are open to the public.

The topics for the town halls will include an introduction to Oklahoma Complete Health and an overview and scope of the Children's Specialty Program. It will also include a discussion of value-added benefits that will be offered to members. Plus, learn how OHCA, Oklahoma Complete Health, Oklahoma Human Services, and the Office of Juvenile Affairs will be working together to better serve you. A question-and-answer session will conclude each town hall.
